First I want to say thank you for letting us be a part of the Habitat for Humanity program. It has kept us safe and allowed us to grow. My mom worked really hard completing her ~~work~~ volunteer work, and we are grateful to have got a home in return.

Currently, we are having a tough time as my mom was sick and had some major PTSD from some previous experiences and had to take a break from work. I also found it unfair that my mom was only given 90 days to find a new job whilst another family was given 365 days to find a new job.

It also doesn't help that the new CEO said that we were missing payments which was not true and HFHV are now using to evict us.

Over the years housing has gone up as well as rent. This would make moving almost impossible. We also put a lot of time and effort into turning this house into our home ~~the~~ by adding appliances and doing garden work, but if we lost our house everything we have been working for would be lost.

My idea of Habitat for Humanity is to help struggling parents find affordable housing not leave them to the streets and I am sure that if we were evicted under these silly circumstances that it wouldn't look good for either of us.

I hope I have made you reconsider your actions and that you will give my mom ^{more} time to help support her family.
